28th February 2014, Stuttgart: Handover of the Presidency



2nd April 2014, Brussels: Sustainable Transport in the Danube Region

- Expert Conference in the Representation of Baden-Wuerttemberg in Brussels
- Topics
 - Multi and Intermodality of the modes of transport
 - Development of port infrastructure as a location factor in the establishment of businesses (example Black Sea port co-operation)
 - Transnational co-operation for improvement of mobility and intermodality.



4th – 5th July 2014, Ulm: Sustainable Mobility and Green Economy in the Danube Region

Baden-Württemberg hat seit 1. Januar 2014 für zwei Jahre den Vorsitz der ARGE Donauländer.

Die Arbeitsgemeinschaft Donauländer

Baden-Württemberg hat am 1. Januar 2014 für zwei Jahre den Vorsitz der Arbeitsgemeinschaft (ARGE) Donauländer von Niederösterreich übernommen.

Die ARGE Donauländer wurde im Mai 1990 mit dem Ziel der „Förderung der Zusammenarbeit ihrer Mitglieder zwecks allseitiger Entwicklung des Donaaraumes im Interesse ihrer Einwohner und einer friedlichen Zusammenarbeit in Europa“ gegründet. Sie umfasst 43 Regionen in zehn Donauanrainerstaaten und ist die älteste interregionale Vereinigung im Donaunraum.

Baden-Württemberg will mit seinem Vorsitz der ARGE Donauländer dazu beitragen, die Regionen im Donaunraum zu stärken und die Zusammenarbeit auf regionaler Ebene weiter voranzubringen. Das Land wird sich weiterhin dafür einsetzen, die Aktivitäten der ARGE Donauländer noch stärker in die 2011 verabschiedete EU-Strategie für den Donaunraum einzubringen und größtmögliche Synergien zu schaffen.
